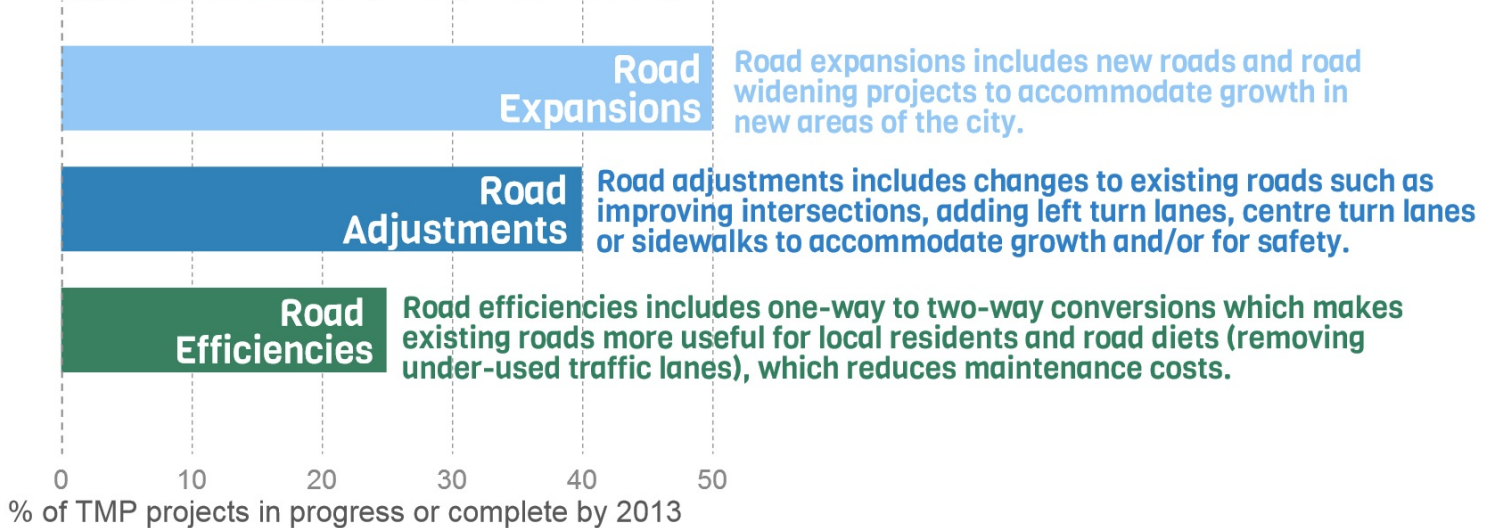


Hamilton's Spending on Roads

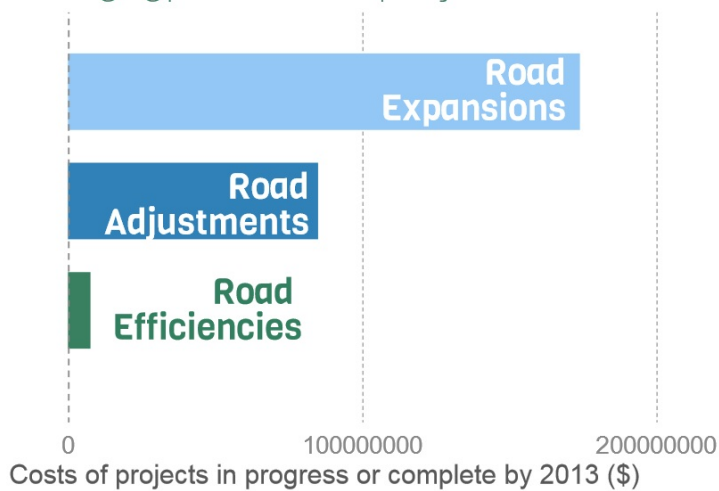
An analysis of Hamilton's road spending shows that 70% of planned road expansion projects to date have been completed, compared to 50% of road adjustment projects and only 25% of road efficiency projects.

Progress on Hamilton's Transportation Master Plan (TMP), by type of road project (2007-2011)



Road expansion projects are the most expensive type of road project, and the city's budgets have already included over \$174 Million for these projects since 2007. Road expansion costs includes design, land acquisition and construction costs, but does not include new on-going operating costs (repair, sweeping, winter maintenance, etc.).
